## BRAGGING RIGHTS

**Karen Adams:** Road's End Reflected Bi Moonlight (Cooper) earned his OJP at the Hoosier Kennel Club agility trial under Judge Laura Kuterbach with a First Place and his OAP at the ACI trial in June under Judge Bob Jeffers with a First Place. He earned his first FAST Preferred leg at the GIBC trial with a First Place under Judge Cheri Tyre-Roberts. At the Muncie Kennel Club, Cooper went WD, BOW, BOH for a 3 point major under Judge Simon Sim. It is now **CH ROAD'S END REFLECTED BI MOONLIGHT OAP OJP!** He went on to receive an OH Group 3 under Judge Alan C. Santos, MD. The Blue Grass Classic was a wonderful 5 days for us. Cooper was Select Dog 4 days and BOS 1 day and BOH all 5 days. He earned 5 majors (3 required), defeated other champions 3 days (3 required) & has 21 of the 25 points needed towards his Grand Championship under judges: Jim Frederiksen, Stephen Dainard, David Bolus, Gopi Krishnan and Neena Van Camp! Cooper was bred by and is co-owned with Chris Schmidt and is Ch Aynsworth No Moon Tonight ROM x O'Sure's Roadsend Echoes Of Love.

Sophie, Alpenglo's Special Edition NA NAJ CGC, earned her third leg in Open Jumpers at the CISSC trial under Judge Mary Mullen. (First Place). She is now: **Alpenglo's Special Edition NA OAJ CGC.** She also received an Achiever Dog Certificate from the AKC.

**Liz Carroll:** Baku (Prelude's Show N' Tell) and Lenny (Whitehall's Corjalin Dream Lens) were both awarded Achiever certificates by AKC. This is a new AKC award for dogs who have qualified in 3 performance events. After the CISSC trial & GIBC, both dogs have two Open Standard legs (fingers crossed for the next trial) & Lenny has two Open Jumpers legs. Baku suffered a set back in that we didn't finish her Novice title before she received two Open Jumpers legs at these trials. Poor record keeping on my part so we need to finish that Novice title! Hopefully, we can finish the Novice title and regain those open legs quickly.
