Trial Site

Obstacles will conform to current AKC Agility Regulations. Electronic Timers will be used at these trials.

Warm up/practice jump: Regulation agility jump will be set up in designated area. X-pens and crates may be left overnight. Neither Pawsitive Partners nor CISSC will be responsible for personal articles left at the site. No grooming is allowed in the building. No dogs may be left overnight.

We will be following local mandated COVID precautions and CDC guidelines in effect the dates of the trial. We will update these in the welcome confirmation email that will be sent close to the trial start dates.

Eligible Dogs

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Exceptions are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, and dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partner may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower, than their proper height division.

Jump Height Card Process

There is a new section in the middle of the entry form to designate whether your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Entry Fees

Fee for each class entry per day: \$19 per run. Checks should be made out to **CISSC**. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Please note, express mail deliveries should contain a signature allowing them to be left at the trial secretary's address without recipient's signature. Maximum of 10 dogs are allowed in each envelope. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the Agreement and Rules. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Confirmations

For those who provide an e-mail address entry received confirmations will be sent as entries are received. Entry accepted confirmations will be sent after the draw. Please be sure to have your e-mail address printed clearly on entry form. After closing date final confirmation and judging schedule will be sent via e-mail. Confirmation via the postal service will only occur if you enclose a self-addressed, stamped postcard with your entry. Judging schedule, worker schedule and exhibitor information will also be available on the trial secretary website, www.loulees-shelties.com after closing.

Refunds

No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entries may be withdrawn at anytime. Fees will be fully refunded (checks shredded) before closing. After closing fees will be refunded minus AKC fees and the closing date is just a week before the trial dates.

Wait List

CISSC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing Saturday, July 24 at 6:00 pm. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Saturday, July 24 at 6:00 pm. Any entries withdrawn that are received by Saturday, July 24 at 6:00 pm will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday August 3 2021 will receive a full refund. A dog withdrawn from the wait list before August 3 will receive a full refund.

Move Ups

Prior to the trial, move ups must be received in writing (email accepted) no later than Monday August 3, 2021 at 6:00 pm. Additionally, move ups will be allowed for Saturday and Sunday during the trial as a result of receiving a title.

COVID-19 Warning and Safety Guidelines

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in public places and events where people are present. As an exhibitor, you understand and assume all risks associated with your participation in this agility trial.

The Central Indiana Shetland Sheepdog Club's (CISSC) primary concern is everyone's safety; therefore, the following will be implemented for our November 20-21, 2021

We will follow state, local and facility rules and guidelines in effect on the dates of the trials. If different, those rules or guidelines will supersede the guidance given below.

- If you are fully vaccinated against Covid-19 you are not required to wear a mask inside or outside of the building.
- If you are not fully vaccinated, you must wear a mask inside the building. You may remove your mask while you run, but you must be put it back on immediately after exiting the ring.
- Anyone who prefers to wear a face mask is welcome to do so. You are responsible for bringing your own mask. There will not any masks to borrow or buy at the trial site.

If any additional safety measures are added or this guidance changes, we will communicate the changes via email prior to the trial or post the guidance at the entrance to the building on the day of the trial.

If you are not feeling well, please stay home. Contact Brenda Peters, our trial secretary, and you will be given a refund (minus AKC fees) for each day you are absent. People who are visibly sick and attend the trial will be asked to leave with no refund.

Noncomplying exhibitors will be asked to leave. At its discretion, CISSC may issue one warning. If you are asked to leave you will not receive a refund.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made. Minor children must be supervised at all times. Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the show site by the Trial Committee.
- Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars, head halter, and special training collars are prohibited on the trial grounds. This includes bark collars.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated agility warm-up area. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. Please help us keep this site clean future use. Hotels/motels are considered to be part of the show environs.
- **AVMA Statement:** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs have appropriate vaccinations and are free of internal and external parasites and communicable diseases

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
