ENTRY FEES & LIMITS

NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH EVENT! IF FEES ARE RECEIVED FOR ONLY ONE EVENT, ONLY THE FIRST EVENT WILL BE PROCESSED. ENTRY FEE is \$31.00 for the first entry of each dog for each event, except in Puppy Classes, Bred-by-Exhibitor Classes & Veteran Classes which are \$25.00 for each event. Each Additional Entry of the same dog is \$25.00 for each event. Sweepstakes is \$15.00 & each dog **MUST ALSO** be entered in a Regular Class. Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition is \$15.00. Junior Showmanship (Saturday P.M. Specialty Show Only) is \$10.00 for each event if entered for "Junior Showmanship Only" or FREE as an Additional Entry. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$2.00 AKC Recording Fee for the Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

SPECIAL SHOW INSTRUCTIONS

- * The Show Site will open for grooming area set up at 4:00 P.M. – 7:00 P.M., Thursday, May 12, 2022 and again at 7:00 A.M., Friday, May 13, 2022 and at 7:00 A.M., Saturday, May 14, 2022.
- * Dogs must be removed from the Show Site immediately following Best of Breed judging on Saturday afternoon, May 14, 2022.
- * Due to the time and expense incurred to clean up the chalk dust, we kindly ask that you please help us to keep the Building clean so that we may continue to use it in the future. Thank you!
- * There will not be space for exercise pens within the Building. Crates must be stacked.
- * NO soft-sided crates in the Building.
- * Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- * **OFFICIAL SHOW SITE LIMITS** shall include all of the area within 30 feet of the Building. There shall be NO SMOKING within the show site limits. All dogs within the show site limits must be eligible to be entered in an AKC show.
- * **UNENTERED DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.**
- * NO FIREARMS are allowed within the show site limits.
- * NO ALCOHOLIC beverages are allowed within the show site limits.
- * NO BABY STROLLERS are allowed in the Building.
- * Food vendors are at nearby exits offering sandwiches, salads, coffee & soft drinks.
- * AGENT'S NAME will be listed. The agent must be at least 18 years of age.
- * Indoor restrooms are available in the Building and handicapped accessible.
- * THE BUILDING IS HEATED AND AIR CONDITIONED.
- * PLEASE TURN OFF CELL PHONES AND/OR PAGERS BEFORE ENTERING THE RING.

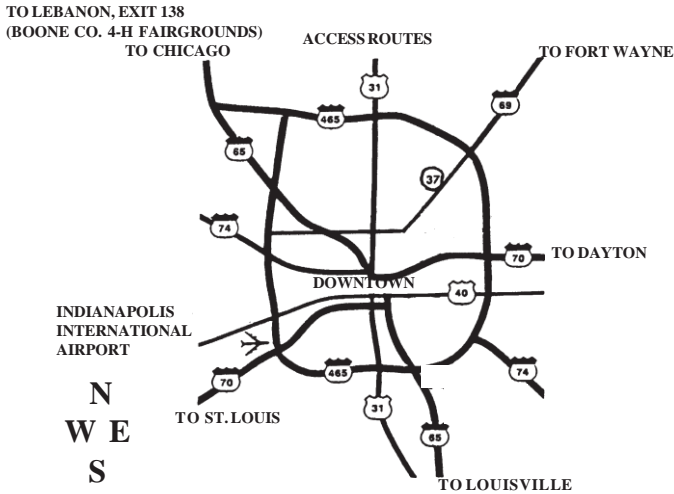

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION FRIDAY, MAY 13 & SATURDAY, MAY 14, 2022

The Four-to-Six Month Beginner Puppy Competition shall be for Shetland Sheepdogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered.

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries for an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers organization, distributed note cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*
- Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination. If the judge finds it necessary to open the mouth, they should disinfect their hands prior to examining other dogs.
- Male puppies without two fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused but the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points must be withheld.
- Dogs with breed standard disqualifications should not be excused but may not receive placements. However, dogs with age related disqualifications such as color (as related to age), height, teeth, etc. are permitted to receive awards in the 4-to-6 Month Puppy classes.
- Dogs must be excused for attacking a person or other dogs.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.
- *Dealing with Misconduct* will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE. The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
