Notice to Exhibitors

✓ AKC fees include an event service fee of \$3.00 and a recording fee of \$.50 for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience Trial. These fees are collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Rules Chap. 11, Sec.2)

 \checkmark Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.

✓ It is expressly understood exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site.
