Notice to Exhibitors

AKC fees include an event service fee of \$4.00 and a recording fee of \$.50 for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience Trial. These fees are collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Rules Chap. 11, Sec.2)

Safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.

It is expressly understood exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fee paid will be made. Any incidents of dog aggression resulting in harm to other dogs or people that occur within the show grounds will be reported by the Show Committee to the proper authorities.

All dogs must be on-leash, crated, securely penned, or otherwise under physical control at all times when not competing. Space is limited; please crate in designated area only and observe marked areas for seating.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by means of riot, civil disturbances, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, fire, or an act of God, emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the

Refunds: Entry fees shall be refunded for a bitch in season, less \$5.00 per day entered, when a letter from your veterinarian is presented before 8:00 a.m. the first day of the trial.

No refunds given under \$10 for incorrect addition. Checks returned from your bank will incur a \$20 charge.

Dogs are not required to be at the Trial until scheduled time of judging; however, exhibitors are responsible for being at the ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Please check in with the Gate Steward.

SPECIAL NOTICES

Transfers will be approved in accord with Chapter 1, Section 16a of the Obedience Regulations, provided that a written request is submitted to the Trial Secretary at least 30 min. prior to the start of the Trial, and that the limit has not been reached in the requested class.

Catalogs will be by pre order only . If you would like a catalog, please include \$5.00 with your entry fee

Qualifying scores are required for all awards.

All dogs must be on-leash, crated, securely penned, or otherwise under physical control at all times when not competing. Space is limited, please crate in designated areas only and observe marked areas for seating.

Due to space restrictions, CISSC reserves the right to ask that no unentered dogs be allowed in the building, including the lobby area as provided in Chapter 11, Section 11 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows".

No Smoking is permitted in the building

A refund of all but \$5.00 of each entry fee per day will be made to an exhibitor with a bitch that has come into season after the close of entries, providing that a statement from a veterinarian is submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than one hour before the beginning of judging on the day of the Trial.

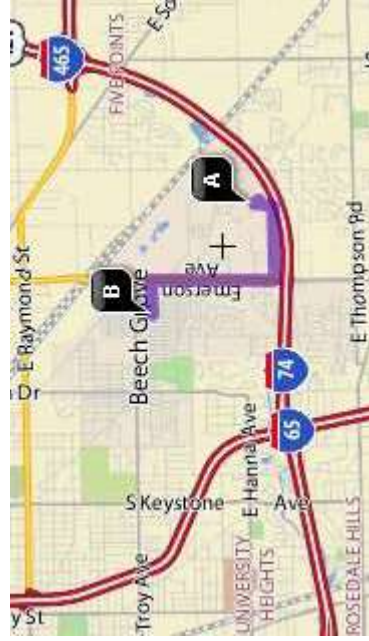
Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., A or B division.

3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC/HERYL (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us). I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION.
